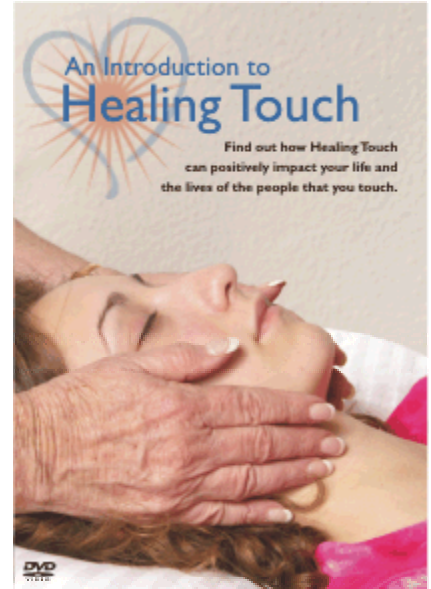
We appreciate your patience as the new staff learns the workings of Healing Touch office.

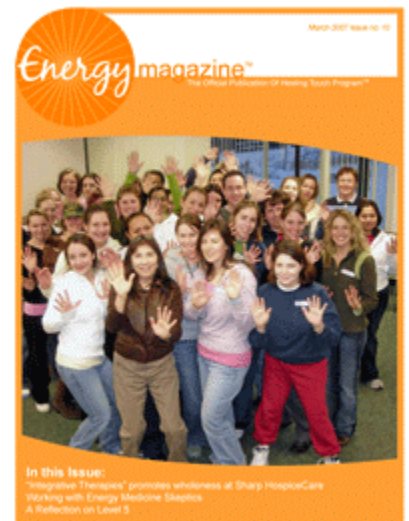
